MAIN ISSUES WITH THE PROPOSED WORKS:

- VicRoads have contradicted themselves throughout the process so far, misleading and proving difficult to communicate with. It just isn't good enough!!
- Isn't it true that if you **downgrade this road** that you don't have to resurface it as often and also have the opportunity to **handover management and maintenance to our local** council?
- **Bushfire evacuation**, existing 4 lanes enables double the amount of people access out of the area proposed line marking will halve this and add to congestion issues in an emergency situation **Woodend & Macedon are high risk fire areas!**
- How can a single lane road with a shared central lane be safer than dual lanes with no shared lane?
- Lets not forget that we already have dedicated turning lanes for our busiest hotspot intersections and still have dual lanes both sides.
- Re-evaluation of road needed, with updated car count, population projections and independent analysis. Industrial sites should be accommodated too - access to Black Forest Timbers for example - no turning lane for trucks to this site on proposed line marking plan.
- This is not a 'fait accompli' we've put the works on hold, now let's stop them for good!
